## Haemostasis Awards

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### THE MARTÍN VILLAR AWARDS

The Martín Villar program's objective is to **support research projects in bleeding disorders (haemophilia and von Willebrand disease) to encourage further investigation in this field.**

Dr. Martín Villar (Valencia, Spain 1922-2011) was a world-renowned haematologist, who pioneered the treatment of haemophilia in Spain.

In 2007, as a tribute to his career, and to honor his contribution to the management of haemophilia, Grifols launched the Martín Villar Awards Program, with the aim of identifying and supporting innovative clinical and scientific work that offers a greater insight into haemostasis.

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### ABOUT MARTÍN VILLAR PROGRAM

The Martín Villar program offers two research grants of €50,000 to the two proposals that best match the program objectives, according to assessment by an independent review committee.

The grants will be awarded in two different categories:

- Basic Research
- Clinical Research

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### WHO CAN APPLY

Scientists or clinicians with innovative ideas relevant to haemophilia and von Willebrand disease are invited to submit their application if they meet the following criteria:

- The contribution is basic or clinical research specifically related to haemophilia and von Willebrand disease pathologies or management with plasma-derived protein therapies.
- The research is conducted at hospitals, universities or independent institutions.
- The research project has goals that reasonably can be achieved within 12 months.
- Applicants are employed or supported by a hospital, university, or independent institution.
- Primary applicant is under the age of 40 at the time of submission.

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## EVALUATIONS AND SELECTION OF RESEARCH PROPOSALS

Applications are evaluated based on four criteria:

- Scientific merit
- Innovation
- Clinical and medical impact
- Quality of research environment

The review board will be looking for significant contributions to basic or clinical research in the field of haemophilia and von Willebrand disease.

Deadline for receipt of Letters of Intent:  
**February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018**

Candidates' notification for submission of Full Proposal:  
**March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018**

Deadline for receipt of Full Proposal:  
**March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018**

Publication of awardees' names on the Grifols website:  
**April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018**

Awards Ceremony:  
**During the World Federation of Hemophilia congress; May, 2018**
